**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court  
(2017-2018)**

An Act Human Accommodations Act.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Emergency Preamble-

2           “Whereas, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is  
3 forthwith to consolidate time and expense involved in the administration of human  
4 demonstrations of skills and knowledge, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law,  
5 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.”

6           Human Accommodations Act Trust and its appointed commissioner is authorized to  
7 provide unused and unlimited treasury notes by the treasury on an ongoing basis for the  
8 following facilities and services:

9           Policy to provide unlimited access, coverage and accommodations for persons who seek  
10 to demonstrate science, technology, education, innovation, health and human services,  
11 government, retail, human equality, improve the standard of living, safety and utility.

To be signed into law before May 1,2017 and to take effect on June 1, 2017 [\$unlimited]
