An Act Human Accommodations Act.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Emergency Preamble-
- 2 "Whereas, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is
- 3 forthwith to consolidate time and expense involved in the administration of human
- 4 demonstrations of skills and knowledge, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law,
- 5 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience."
- 6 Human Accommodations Act Trust and its appointed commissioner is authorized to
- 7 provide unused and unlimited treasury notes by the treasury on an ongoing basis for the
- 8 following facilities and services:
- Policy to provide unlimited access, coverage and accommodations for persons who seek
- to demonstrate science, technology, education, innovation, health and human services,
- government, retail, human equality, improve the standard of living, safety and utility.

To be signed into law before May 1,2017 and to take effect on June 1, 2017 [\$unlimited]
