**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to the Communication/Media Park and Community Act.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Emergency Preamble-

2 “Whereas, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is
3 forthwith to consolidate time and expense involved in the administration of
4 Communication/Media Park and Community, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency
5 law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.”

6 Policy to Provide unlimited access, coverage and accommodations to develop and
7 administer Communication/Media Parks and Communities.

8 Communication/Media Park and Community Act Trust and its appointed commissioner is
9 authorized to provide unused and unlimited treasury notes by the treasury on an ongoing basis
10 for the following facilities and services:

11 1.Communication Community-a multi parcel commercial museum park with an owner
12 community of artists', media and museum facilities in the arts of theater, motion pictures,
13 television, internet and other broadcast production and live display entertainment, art and
14 education.

15 2.To be signed into law before May 1,2017 and to take effect on June 1, 2017
