**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to reasonable municipal expenses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Section 69H of Chapter 164 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following clause:-

3 “(5) the board shall consider the requests of municipalities for reimbursement of expenses
4 spent in relation to the application and may assess fees on applicants for reasonable municipal
5 expenses related to the application.”
