*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. Section 85B of Chapter 164 of the General Laws, appearing in the 2014

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of subsection (f) the following

3 sentence:- The community liaison shall provide 3 times daily updates on estimated return of

4 service and the status of work being performed in the community to municipal officials.
