An Act relative to requiring notification of hazardous utility work to local and regional emergency departments.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, utility companies would be
- 2 require the notification of both local and regional police, fire, emergency and all other related
- 3 public works departments of any hazardous public work projects conducted by that utility
- 4 company or an independent contractor within their jurisdiction.
