- 3 inserting in place thereof the following: "twenty dollars"
- 4 Section 2. Section 18A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 5 Official Edition, is hereby amended in paragraph 4, line 8, by striking the words "two dollars"
- 6 and inserting in place thereof the following: "forty dollars"
