An Act clarifying the definition of commercial motor vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The first paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the  
2 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the seventh sentence the following  
3 sentence:-

4           Applications by natural persons for registration of dual rear wheel axle pick-up trucks  
5 with 5 or more wheels on the ground and not used for commercial purposes shall not be  
6 classified as a commercial vehicle for the purposes of registration.
