An Act requiring medical exams for certain school bus drivers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Section 8A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,
- 2   is hereby amended by striking out, in line 12, the words “licensed physician within a three” and
- 3   inserting in place thereof the following words:- medical professional listed on the Federal Motor
- 4   Carrier Safety Administration’s National Registry of Certified Medical Examiners within a 6.
