An Act relative to parking violation notices.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 20A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the  
2   2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 40 by inserting after the word “vehicle” the  
3   following:- or if a city or town has permitted said notice to be delivered by mail,

4           SECTION 2. Section 20A1/2 of chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby amended in line  
5   32 by inserting after the word “vehicle” the following:- , or if permitted by cities accepting this  
6   section, sent to the offender,
