**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to handicapped placards.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The ninth paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 317, the word “registration” and
3 inserting in place thereof the following words:-

4 “registration, a vehicle bearing a Commonwealth of Massachusetts registration used for
5 the transportation of handicapped persons,”
