**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court  
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to the use of the Neponset Valley Parkway in the town of Milton.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. No person shall operate a truck, bus, camper, trailer, semi-trailer unit,  
2 mobile home or any vehicle with a seating capacity of more than 12 persons on the Neponset  
3 Valley Parkway in the Town of Milton, a roadway under the control of the department of  
4 conservation and recreation within the urban parks district; provided, however, that a school bus  
5 and pickup truck or van having a gross vehicle weight of 5,000 pounds or less and a maximum  
6 overall height of 7 feet or less shall be permitted. Prohibited vehicles may access Neponset  
7 Valley Parkway only to abutting residential homes and healthcare facilities located on the  
8 roadway and only with the express consent of the department of conservation and recreation. A  
9 violation of this act shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100 not more than \$500.
