*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. clause 43 of section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws, as appearing in the  
2   2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 317, after the words “of the United  
3   States,” the following:- “or are eligible to retire under Section 31 of Chapter 33,”
