In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to veterans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 21 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting, after section 3G, the following section:-
- 3 Section 3H. Veterans, as defined by clause 43, section 7 of chapter 4, shall not be
- 4 required to pay charges and fees, including day-use parking fees and recreation visitor fees, for
- 5 entrance to public forest lands and public beaches under the control and care of the department of
- 6 conservation and recreation.

- 7 SECTION 2. Section 2D of chapter 132A, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking
- 8 out, in line 16, the words "disabled veteran" and inserting in place thereof the following words:-
- 9 Veterans, as defined by clause 43, section 7 of chapter 4.
