## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to the endowment match program.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in the general appropriation act
2	and other appropriations acts for fiscal year 2018, the sums set forth in section 2A are hereby
3	appropriated from the General Fund unless specifically designed otherwise in this act or in those
4	appropriations acts, for the several purposes and subject to the conditions specified in this act or
5	in those appropriations acts, and subject to the laws regulating the disbursement of public funds
6	for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2018. These sums shall be in addition to any amounts
7	previously appropriated and made available for the purposes of those items. These sums shall be
8	made available until June 30, 2019.

9 SECTION 2A. To provide for certain unanticipated obligations of the commonwealth, to 10 provide for an alteration of purpose for current appropriations, and to meet certain requirements 11 of law, the sums set forth in this section are hereby appropriated from the General Fund unless 12 specifically designated otherwise in this section, for the several purposes and subject to the 13 conditions specified in the section, and subject to the laws regulating the disbursement of public 14 funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018. These sums shall be in addition to any amounts previously appropriated and made available for the purposes of those items. These sums shall be
made available until June 30, 2019
