Senate, January 18, 2018 -- Offered by Senator Cynthia Stone Creem relative to establishing a Special Senate Committee on Net Neutrality and Consumer Protection

**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

1 *Ordered*, That, there shall be a special committee on the part of the Senate on net
2 neutrality and consumer protection. The committee shall consist of 7 members of the Senate, 5 of
3 whom shall be appointed by the senate president and 2 of whom shall be appointed by the senate
4 minority leader. The committee shall review the Federal Communications Commission’s order
5 entitled “Restoring Internet Freedom”, which was adopted on December 14, 2017. The
6 committee shall make recommendations concerning the Senate response to this order, with the
7 goal of protecting Massachusetts consumers. The committee may file its recommendations
8 including, but not limited to, legislation, with the clerk of the Senate not later than April 13,
9 2018.
