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**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court  
(2017-2018)**  
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An Act relative to compliance with the fair minimum wage.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 16 of chapter 151 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

2 Employers subject to a minimum fair wage order under this chapter shall provide each  
3 employee receiving a salary with an hourly equivalent comparison of the employee’s salary and  
4 the minimum fair wage under chapter 151. The comparison shall be in written form and shall  
5 accompany each payment made to employee. If the hourly salary amount is less than the  
6 minimum fair wage, the employer may be subject to sections 19 and 20 of this chapter.
