An Act relative to background checks of persons providing direct services to children in a school setting or program.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 38R of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “district”, in line 10, the
3 following words: - “, or any persons providing direct services to children in a school setting or
4 program”.

5 SECTION 2. Section 38R of chapter 71 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby
6 amended by inserting after the word “grounds”, in line ____, the following words: - “, or any
7 persons providing direct services to children in a school setting or program”.

8 SECTION 3. Section 38R of Chapter 71 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby
9 amended by inserting after the word “employer”, in line ____, the following words: - “ or any
10 persons providing direct services to children in a school setting or program”.
