An Act regarding transfer of retained earnings surplus in the town of Clinton.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Pursuant to the requirements of MGL Chapter 44 section 53F1/2 and  
2 notwithstanding any general or special laws to the contrary, the Town of Clinton will be  
3 authorized to transfer retained earnings surplus from the Landfill Enterprise Fund into the  
4 Capital Projects & Infrastructure Improvements Stabilization Fund. The Town of Clinton shall,  
5 by ordinance, establish guidelines for the transfer of funds from the Landfill Enterprise Fund to  
6 the Capital Projects & Infrastructure Improvements Stabilization Fund.

7           SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall take effect upon its passage.
