An Act adding a fifth member to the Board of Elections Commission in the City of Everett.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The third sentence of section 16A of chapter 51 of the General Laws, as  
2    appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "persons"  
3    the following words:- "except in the City of Everett, where the Board shall have a fifth member  
4    who shall be the City Clerk or his/her designee the Assistant City Clerk."

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
