An Act exempting all positions in the police department of the town of Williamstown from the civil service law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, all members of  
2 the police department of the town of Williamstown shall be exempt from chapter 31 of the  
3 General Laws.

4           SECTION 2. This act shall not impair the civil service status of any member of the police  
5 department of the town of Williamstown employed by the town on the effective date of this act.

6           SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
