**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act authorizing the acquisition of easement interests for a pumping station in the city of Easthampton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the
2 contrary, the town of Southampton is hereby authorized to acquire, by gift, purchase, eminent
3 domain, or otherwise, easement interests for the purpose of the construction, operation and
4 maintenance of a pumping station and related facilities and appurtenances, and further for the
5 purpose of access and the installation of utilities to said pumping station, in, upon and across
6 property in Easthampton, being Easthampton Tax Map 164, lot 11, described in a deed recorded
7 with Hampshire registry of deeds book 2284, page 250, or in, upon and across property in
8 Easthampton, being Easthampton Tax Map 164, lot 12, described in a deed recorded with
9 Hampshire registry of deeds book 2284, page 230, on such terms and conditions as the Select
10 Board may deem appropriate.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
