#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to school funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The secretary of administration and finance in cooperation with the commissioner of
- 2 revenue and the commissioner of education as appearing in Section 3A of Chapter 70 of the
- 3 General Laws shall include in said criteria, components, equations, and underlying data
- 4 necessary to generate the required minimum local contribution, a new component.
- 5 Such new component shall, for municipalities with a population of 6,000 or less, exclude
- data regarding the highest five percent and lowest five percent of property values and resident
- 7 annual income of said municipalities, from calculations regarding local contribution.
