The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act establishing open ballot primaries in the commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
2 commonwealth shall adopt an open ballot primary process for all state and federal primary
3 elections. For the purposes of this section, "open ballot" shall mean the primary candidates for all
4 political parties shall be listed on a single ballot, to be voted on by registered voters, regardless
5 of party enrollment.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2018.
