In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act to expand voting rights.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 47A of chapter 51 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after first paragraph the following paragraphs:-
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person who is 17 years of age on the date
- 4 of a primary election shall be permitted to vote in that primary election if that person reaches the
- 5 age of 18 on or before the date of the immediately following general election.
- For the purposes of this section, an individual who is 17 years of age and will be 18 years
- 7 of age on the date of the general election shall be deemed competent to execute and attest to any
- 8 voter registration forms.
