**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to the pesticide board.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 132B is hereby amended by striking paragraph 5 and inserting in
2 place thereof, the following paragraph:-

3 The board, in addition to other powers conferred in this chapter, shall advise the
4 commissioner of food and agriculture with respect to the implementation and administration of
5 this chapter. The commissioner of food and agriculture shall consult and concur with the
6 commissioner of environmental protection and commissioner of public health when rendering a
7 decision under section 13 of this chapter, relative to the protection of groundwater sources of
8 drinking water from pesticide contamination.
