In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to the use of crossbows in hunting.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 64 of Chapter 131 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 striking, in the title, the word "bows."
- 3 SECTION 2. Said section 64 is hereby further amended by striking the words "or any
 4 crossbow."
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 69 of Chapter 131 is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety
 6 and replacing it with the following:-
- Chapter 131, Section 69. A person shall not carry or use a bow and arrow or crossbow
 while hunting unless said bow and arrow or crossbow meet such requirements as may be set by
 rules and regulations which the director is hereby authorized to promulgate. Such rules and

- 10 regulations shall prescribe general design, weight of pull, and type of bows and arrows or
- 11 crossbows, and shall conform to standards generally accepted for hunting purposes.
