An Act relative to the timely disposal of contraband drugs.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2   department of environmental protection shall develop and implement a program to ensure that  
3   municipal police departments without a permit to operate a mobile drug incinerator under 310  
4   CMR 7.02 are able to dispose of waste medications and contraband drugs in a timely manner and  
5   the department shall assist municipal police departments in doing so.
