In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to consumer notification.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Section 4 of
- 2 Chapter 1751 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,
- 3 shall be amended by adding at the end thereof the following:-
- 4 "(f) an insurance institution shall annually notify members of the expiration date and
- 5 requirements for reimbursement opportunities for health memberships within ninety days, but
- 6 not later than thirty days before such reimbursement opportunities expire.
