An Act relative to transportation network companies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (c) of section 3 of Chapter 159A1/2 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by striking out clause (iv) and inserting in place thereof the following:

3 (iv) that the transportation network company disclose to riders the fare or fare calculation  
4 method on its website or within the online application.

5 SECTION 2. Clause (viii) of subsection (c) of section 3 of Chapter 159A1/2 of the  
6 General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the words “customer service hotline” the  
7 following words:- or online system

8 SECTION 3. Clause (viii) of subsection (c) of section 3 of Chapter 159A1/2 of the  
9 General Laws is hereby further amended by inserting after the words “hotline number” the  
10 following words:- or link to the online system

11 SECTION 4. Section 2 of Chapter 159A1/2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
12 striking out subsection (e) and replacing with the following:-

- 13 (e) A transportation network company shall establish and implement a written policy
- 14 capping dynamic pricing during a federal or a governor-declared state of emergency.
