## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act eliminating form 901 reporting requirement.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 15A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out section 15C and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following section:-
- 4 "Section 15C. Each institution within the system of public higher education shall
- 5 annually produce audited financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting
- 6 principles, generally accepted auditing standards, and generally accepted governmental auditing
- 7 standards. The statements shall be in accordance with procedures for timeliness and for
- 8 disclosures as proscribed by the office of the state comptroller and approved by the state auditor.
- 9 The statements shall include all expenditures and revenues from all appropriated and non-
- appropriated funds and be filed with the governor, office of state comptroller, the board of higher
- education, the house and senate committees on ways and means, and the joint committee on
- higher education no later than October 15 each year."
