**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act modernizing the commonwealth's larceny laws.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 30 of chapter 266 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 9, the words “two hundred and fifty
3 dollars” and inserting in place thereof the following figure:- \$1,000.

4 Section 2. Said section 30 of said chapter 266, as so appearing, is hereby further
5 amended by striking out, in lines 13 and 14, the words “two hundred and fifty dollars” and
6 inserting in place thereof the following figure:- \$1,000.
