An Act relative to the valuation of professional practices in divorce proceedings.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 34 of Chapter 208 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition  
2 is hereby amended online 22 by adding after the word marriage the following new sentence: “In  
3 fixing the value of a professional corporation the court shall value the asset as the price at which  
4 the property would change hands between a willing buyer and a willing seller, neither being  
5 under any compulsion to buy or sell and both having relevant knowledge of relevant facts and  
6 the court shall allow key man and marketability discounts”.
