An Act relative to safe and secure waiting areas.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 17 of chapter 211B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 28, the words “subject to  
3 appropriation and to available resources”.

4           SECTION 2. Section 17 of chapter 211B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
5 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 35, the words “subject to  
6 appropriation and to available resources”.
