An Act relative to archaic crimes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.

2 SECTION 2. Section 18 of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.

3 SECTION 3. Section 20 of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.

4 SECTION 4. Section 21 of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.

5 SECTION 5. Section 21A of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.

6 SECTION 6. Said chapter 272 is hereby further amended by striking out section 34, as
7 appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

8 Section 34. Whoever commits a sexual act on an animal, uses an object to sexually abuse
9 an animal, or knowingly permits a sexual act with an animal on any premises under such

10 person's control, shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for not more than 20
11 years or in a house of correction for not more than 2 ½ years, and by a fine of not more than
12 \$5,000.

13 SECTION 7. Section 36 of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby repealed.
