Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby repealed. 2 SECTION 2. Section 18 of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby repealed. 3 SECTION 3. Section 20 of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby repealed. 4 SECTION 4. Section 21 of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby repealed. 5 SECTION 5. Section 21A of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby repealed. 6 SECTION 6. Said chapter 272 is hereby further amended by striking out section 34, as 7 appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-8 Section 34. Whoever commits a sexual act on an animal, uses an object to sexually abuse 9 an animal, or knowingly permits a sexual act with an animal on any premises under such

- person's control, shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for not more than 20 years or in a house of correction for not more than 2 ½ years, and by a fine of not more than
- 12 \$5,000.
