An Act strengthening identity law.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 37E of chapter 266 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 26, the word "\$5,000" and inserting in
3 place thereof the following word:- \$10,000.

4 SECTION 2. Said section of chapter 266 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
5 amended by striking out, in line 27, the words "two and one-half" and inserting in place thereof
6 the following word:- ten.

7 SECTION 3. Said section of chapter 266 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
8 amended by striking out, in line 38, the word "\$5,000" and inserting in place thereof the
9 following word:- \$10,000.

10 SECTION 4. Said section of chapter 266 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
11 amended by striking out, in line 39, the words "two and one-half" and inserting in place thereof
12 the following word:- ten.
