An Act prohibiting falsification or impersonation of an emergency medical technician and/or paramedic.

1 SECTION 1. Section 33 of chapter 268, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by inserting, in line 9, after the words “department of revenue” the words: - “or
3 emergency medical technician, or paramedic,”.
