An Act strengthening punishments for the distribution of heroin.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 34 of Chapter 94C of the General Laws is hereby amended by replacing the  
2 sentence beginning with “Any” in line 9 with the following new sentence:-

3           “Any person who violates this section by possessing with the intent to distribute heroin  
4 shall for the first offense be punished by imprisonment in a house of correction for not more than  
5 five years or by a fine of not more than five thousand dollars, or both, and for a second or  
6 subsequent offense shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for not less than ten  
7 years nor more than twenty years or by a fine of not more than fifty thousand dollars and  
8 imprisonment in a jail or house of correction for not more than ten years.
