In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to sex offender registration.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 178E of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (q) the following subsection:-

3	Subsection (r). All sex offenders, convicted or adjudicated of a sex offense, subsequent to
4	the enactment of the Jacob Wetterling Crimes Against Children and Sexually Violent Offender
5	Registration Act (the Wetterling Act), which has been designated a sexually violent offense or a
6	sex offense against a child, requiring by operation of law a minimum of Level 1 life time
7	registration for those convicted as adults and 20 year registration for those adjudicated as
8	juveniles, to be required within 72 hours to register with the Sex Offender Registry Board as
9	level 1 sex offenders, pending the exercise of their due process rights that the Sex Offender

- 10 Registration Board is statutorily required to afford them prior to requiring them to register at
- 11 their final registration level, Level 1, 2 or 3.
