An Act relative to the waiving of fees for the declaration of homestead for disabled veterans.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 38 of chapter 262 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following:-

3           “No fee for recording a declaration of homestead shall be issued to a disabled veteran, as  
4 defined in section 1 of chapter 31.”
