**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to impersonating a public officer.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 33 of chapter 268 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 3, after the word “police officer,” the
3 following words:- “fire fighter, EMS first responder,”.

4 SECTION 2. Said section 33 of chapter 268, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
5 striking out, in lines 10-11, the words “such or requires a person to aid or assist him in a matter
6 pertaining to the duty of such officer,” and inserting in place thereof the following:- “such,
7 requires a person to aid or assist him in a matter pertaining to the duty of such officer, or
8 knowingly and intentionally obtains money, property or another tangible benefit through such
9 fraudulent representation,”
