An Act establishing a sick leave bank for John J. Monahan, an employee of the Trial Court.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Trial Court, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the trial  
2           court shall establish a sick leave bank for John J. Monahan, an employee of the trial court  
3           security department at the Edward W. Brooke Courthouse. Any employee of the trial court may  
4           voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by  
5           John J. Monahan. Whenever John J. Monahan terminates employment with the department or  
6           requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be  
7           transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for

- 8 absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave
- 9 bank as determined by the trial court.
