In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to unemployment insurance.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 24 of chapter 151A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended in subsection (a) by striking out in lines 3 and 4 the words
- 3 "Have been paid wages in the base period amounting to at least thirty times the weekly benefit
- 4 rate" and inserting in place thereof the following:-
- 5 "Have been paid wages in at least two quarters of the base period amounting to at least
- 6 thirty times the weekly benefit rate"
