An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Sue Turner, an employee of the Executive Office of Health and Human Services.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the executive office of health  
2           and human services shall establish a sick leave bank for Sue Turner, an employee of MassHealth.  
3           Any employee of the executive office may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or  
4           vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Sue Turner. Whenever Sue Turner terminates  
5           employment with the executive office or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining  
6           time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave  
7           bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the  
8           establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the executive office.
