1 *Ordered*, That, the Senate hereby calls for a joint session of the two Houses, conformable
2 to the provisions of Article XLVIII (as amended by Article LXXXI) of the Amendments to the
3 Constitution, to consider the following proposals:

4 Proposal for a legislative amendment to the Constitution requiring a supermajority vote
5 for the utilization of rainy day funds (see Senate, No. 15), with reference to which the committee
6 on State Administration and Regulatory Oversight has reported, recommending that the
7 amendment ought NOT to pass.
