2 to the provisions of Article XLVIII (as amended by Article LXXXI) of the Amendments to the
3 Constitution, to consider the following proposal:

4 Proposal for a legislative amendment to the Constitution establishing an independent
5 redistricting commission (see Senate, No. 11), with reference to which the committee on Election
6 Laws has reported, recommending that the amendment ought NOT to pass.
