The Massachusetts Department of Public Health (Department) has received your Plan of Correction dated November 29, 2017. After review, the Department finds the plan appropriately addresses all the violations noted with the following exception:

1. In regards to the issue of overcrowding, the Department appreciates the limitations of correctional facilities and the need to accommodate the ever-increasing population; however we remain concerned with the overcrowded conditions. According to *105 CMR 451.321(B)*: "*For inmates usually locked in for less than ten hours per day, contain at least 70 square feet of floor space for a single inmate.*" The cells in the B Wing at your facility are triple bunked, therefore requiring 210 square feet of floor space. The cells in the B Wing measured 120 square feet.

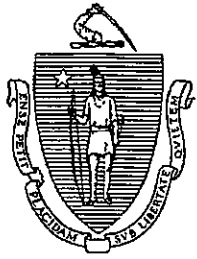

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health (Department) has received your Plan of Correction in response to my inspection on January 31, 2018. After review, the Department finds the plan appropriately addresses all of the violations noted in the report with the following exceptions:

1. Where you indicate "toilet and hand wash facilities are located within close proximity to this area," the Department remains concerned with the lack of handwash sinks in the Intake Trailer and the Medical Exam Rooms. The Department recommends installing a handwash sink in these areas so employees and inmates do not need to leave the area to wash their hands.
2. In regards to the issue of overcrowding, the Department appreciates the limitations of correctional facilities and the need to accommodate the ever-increasing population; however we remain concerned with the overcrowded conditions.
