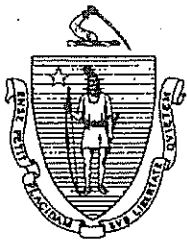

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health (Department) has received your Plan of Correction in response to my inspection on May 9, 10, and 11, 2018. After review, the Department requests the corrective actions taken and estimated date of completion for the following unaddressed violations:

1. The broken hand dryer in the Basement of H Building;
2. Toilet # 4 not flushing properly in Bathroom # L1-24 of Dorm L2; and
3. The soffit damage on the outside of Tower # 3.

The POC submitted does not appropriately address the violations listed below. The Department requests you submit a plan indicating the specific corrective steps taken and estimated date of completion for the following violations:

1. Floor paint damage in Bathroom # L1-14;
2. Floor damage in shower # 1, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 of Shower Room # L1-13 A & B;

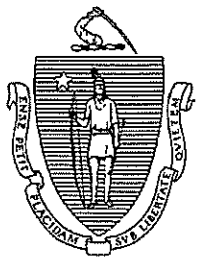

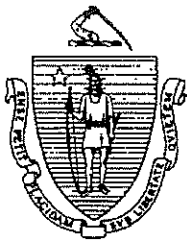
