The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to collective bargaining agreements.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, or any collective bargaining
- 2 agreement to the contrary, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts/NAGE Health and Welfare
- 3 Trust Fund and the NAGE, SEIU Local 5000/Trial Court of Massachusetts Health and Welfare
- 4 Trust Fund, may by a fifty percent vote of their respective trustees or other governing bodies
- 5 reimburse on a monthly basis those employees who are covered by a collective bargaining
- 6 agreement, but who are not members of the union that negotiated the agreement, a sum equal to
- 7 that sent to the Trust Funds by the employer on their behalf. Said reimbursed employee shall not
- 8 be eligible for any of the programs offered by the above Trusts.
